Big event coming up in Goulburn

The Golden Era Auto Racing Club (GEAR) is organizing a celebration of what they are calling the 85th anniversary of the first Australian Grand Prix, said to have been held at the Goulburn showgrounds on 15 January 1927. The celebration will commence on Friday 13 January 2012 at Belmore Park in the centre of Goulburn at around 10 a.m. with a display of vintage cars, motorcycles and racing cars. There will be entertainment, an official opening ceremony and in the evening a free outdoor movie show including comedies of the 1920s. If you turn up in period costume, you might even be selected by the wandering judges to receive a fashion award.



Track events will follow on Saturday and Sunday at Wakefield Park. Club members who have vintage vehicles are invited to display them at Belmore Park on 13 January, and those who don't have such machines are of course welcome to go along and have a look. Yarralumla is on again this year


